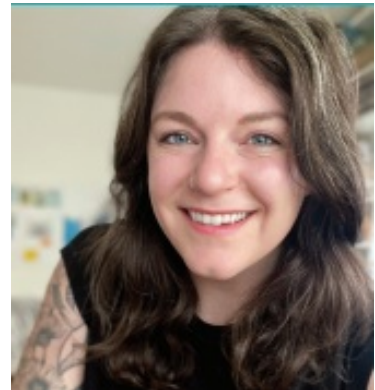

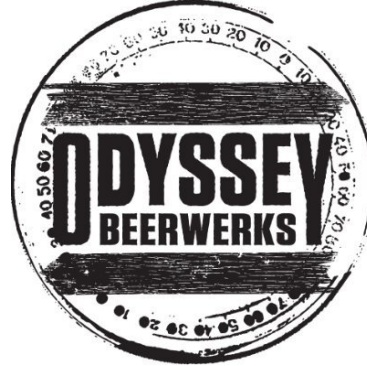

No children allowed.**

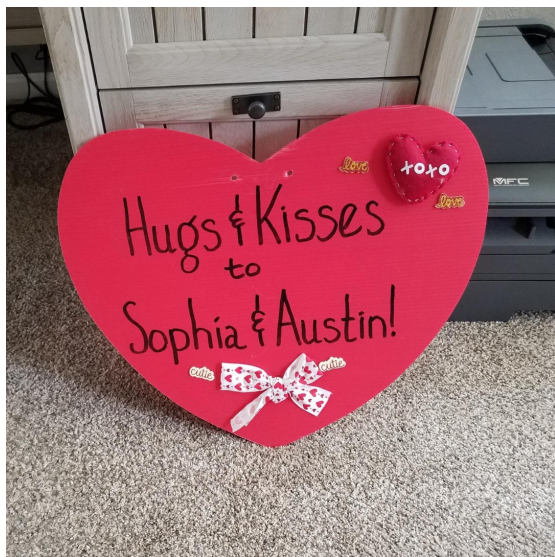
